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


JOHN SYLVIA CDEI 2021-2022 NCREEA BOARD MEMBER

CRAM for the EXAM

CRAM for the Exam was developed by Kim Stotesbury, educational powerhouse of KimCo RE Education Services. This interactive program with asynchronous and synchronous student learning opportunities, was designed as an online resource that includes a digital CRAM book, audio CRAM book, audio/video lectures, word match games, practice exams and an agency quiz.

CRAM for the Exam consists of critical content only and very studentfocused. The CRAM book is clearly marked for level 1, 2 & 3 content, along with problem topic arrows highlighting content that students need to focus extra attention on, in addition to the North Carolina flag to draw the student's attention to a national topic with state specific application.

Kim was also a past recipient of the NCREEA "Educator of the Year Award" and the NC Real Estate Commission's "Billie J. Mercer Excellence in Education Award" along with many other recognitions.

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
